

HISTORIC BUILDING RECORDING

Typical examples of historic building recording projects, carried out in response to development and restoration (i.e PPG15- initiated). Most structures are Grade II Listed. The 'level' of recording depends on the extent of change or loss a building is likely to suffer during proposed works, and follows English Heritage guidance.

These examples have been recorded to Level 3 requiring elevation drawings, floor plans, comprehensive photographic record and an appropriate level of descriptive and historical analysis.
